Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time – February 8, 2026 -

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

There are occasions when someone might ask me my age. When I tell them that I am 60 years old, if they are older than me will say, “Oh Fr. Tom, you are young, you are just a baby.” I know that with many people in our community who are in their 80s and 90s, 60 is definitely younger. I know I could possibly have 25 to 30 years ahead of me, but nobody knows the day or the time when God may call us home.

While I turned 60 this past year, not all 60 year olds are the same, especially when we do not know the health and welfare of each person that age. I do not really like sharing about my health status, but maybe it can be helpful on looking at this 60 year old. In the past three years I have learned that both of my knees are two-thirds bone on bone with a touch of arthritis. I most likely will have a couple of knee replacements down the road.

Twenty years I learned that I have a leaky heart valve, which means one-third of the blood goes back into the previous chamber of the heart with each beat. It means my heart has to work a little harder at pumping the blood through my body. I also have high blood pressure that doesn't help things. I will probably have a heart valve replacement sometime in the years to come. I am not sharing this with you for sympathy, but rather to let you know if you see me hobbling around or short of breath or something more grave happens you will not be surprised and say, “but he is only 60.”

This does connect with the health and well-being of our parishes. People will often say to me, “You must be busy father, running around to all those parishes.” Driving around to celebrate Sunday Mass is the easy part. All the other aspects of being a pastor from administration to pastoral care to facilitating Christian formation becomes the challenging part. They are challenging because the resources and support that has been helpful in the recent past for many parishes seems to have slipped away. And we are only talking about trying to maintain parish life as we remember it, not moving our communities into the mission of evangelization.

We are all facing many challenges as individuals and as a community. I will do my best to try and take care of myself, while currently running around to take care of the daily routines of parish life. It is most likely that both pastoring the parishes and caring for my health will take a back seat. Serving as manager and chaplain each day will still take up a lot of time.
