Fourth Sunday of Lent – March 15, 2026 – National Catholic Sisters Week

There are days, weeks, and even months that are designated to celebrate people or observe issues each year like Earth Day on April 22nd, Week of Prayer for Christian Unity each January 18th to 25th and Black History Month every February. The month of March is Women's History month and this past week was the 115th year of International Women's Day on March 8th and Catholics in the U.S. observed National Catholic Sisters Week.

National Catholic Sisters Week is an annual celebration that takes place from March 8th–14th. Created to honor women religious, it is a series of events that instruct, enlighten, and bring greater focus to the lives of these incredible women.
