Third Sunday of Lent – March 8, 2026 -

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We are entering the third week of Lent and there are three and half weeks to find opportunities to enrich our spiritual life. There are opportunities to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. There will be a Lenten Communal Penance service on Sunday, March 15th at 3:00pm at St. Nicholas church. Priests from the neighboring parishes in our area will be there to hear confessions.

An opportunity for an ecumenical Lenten prayer service through a group of churches called the Ambassadors for Christ. In 1999, Sr. Annette Amendolia, S.N.D., the pastoral associate of St. Stephen of Hungry and SS Cyril & Methodius, had a dream of uniting the churches on the east side of Youngstown. She walked across the street to meet the neighbors. And so it began, a sharing of prayer, scripture, music and fellowship. This group chose their name, Ambassadors For Christ, based on the reading 2 Corinthians 5:20 that is proclaimed on Ash Wednesday.


Each year since, they have begun Lent with an ecumenical sharing of the ashes on Ash Wednesday and continue each Wednesday throughout Lent at each of the churches involved in the Ambassadors For Christ. Currently the churches involved are; St. Angela Merici Parish, Mt. Zion Baptist Church, Mt. Sinai Missionary Baptist Church, and We Walk By Faith Bible Church.

And in this 27th year of the group, the Ambassadors have followed me southeast and Christ the Good Shepherd Parish and Our Lady of the Holy Rosary Parish will host an evening of prayer and fellowship.

We will host the Ambassadors for Christ service on Wednesday, March 11th at St. John the Baptist church at 7:00pm with Pastor Jack Petis speaking and on Wednesday, March 18th at Our Lady of the Holy Rosary church at 7:00pm with Msgr. Robert Siffrin speaking. It is an opportunity to welcome our brothers and sisters as fellow Christians on our Lenten journey. May your Lenten journey continue to be a time of prayer, repentance, and growing in your relationship with our Lord.
