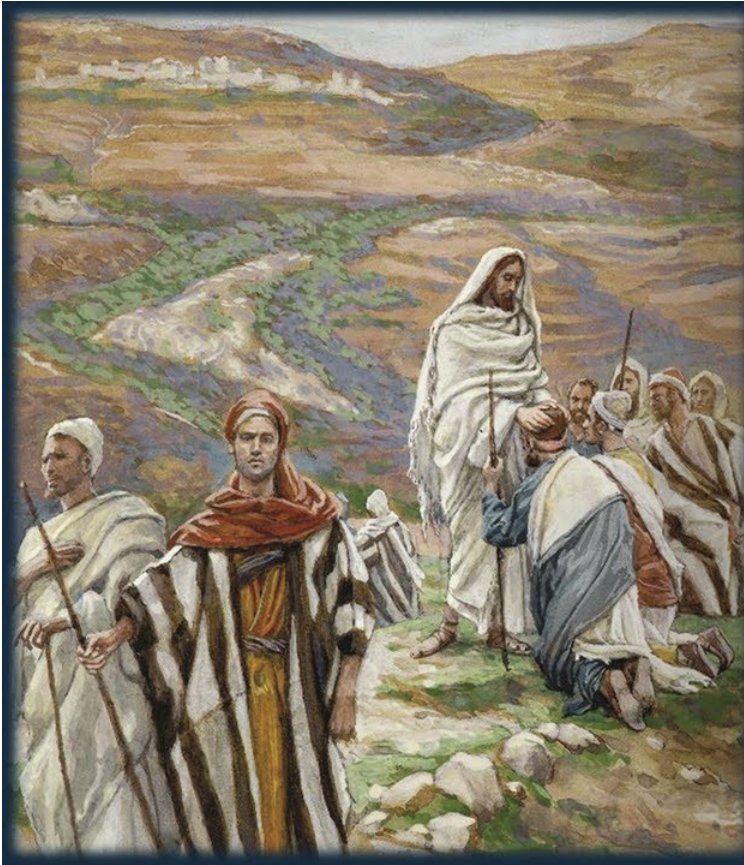

HAPPY FATHER’S DAY

In 1909, Sonora Smart Dodd, one of six children raised by her widowed father, thought it was only right that we honor our fathers as we honor our mothers. After gathering enough support from the local churches, businesses, and government officials of Spokane, the State of Washington became the first state to officially celebrate Father’s Day on June 19, 1910. In 1924, President Calvin Coolidge urged state governments to observe Father’s Day. It was not until 1972 that President Nixon signed a proclamation making Father’s Day a federal holiday.

As we honor our fathers this weekend, we extend our gratitude, appreciation, and prayer to all fathers and father figures. We express our love for our fathers, stepfathers, grandfathers and those who have been father figures in our lives. Let us pray for continued blessings for fathers.

A Father’s Day Prayer

Gracious God, we give our thanks for the fathers in our lives. Fatherhood is not easily learned and lived, and reality teaches us that some fathers do well and some fall short.
