World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation – September 1, 2026

In 2015, Pope Francis established Sept. 1 as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, encouraging Catholics around the world to pray for our common home. In his letter establishing the day as an annual celebration, the Holy Father wrote that its purpose was to “offer individual believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation as well as his pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live.”

Season of Creation - September 1st – October 4th

The World Day of Prayer marks the beginning of the Season of Creation, September 1st through October 4th, which culminates with the feast day of St. Francis of Assisi, the patron of ecology and animals. The Season of Creation is the annual Christian celebration of prayer and action for our common home. Together, the ecumenical family around the world unites to pray for and act to protect God’s creation.

Mass for the Care of Creation

In July 2025, Pope Leo XIV approved and ordered the promulgation of a new Mass prayers and readings, "For the Care of Creation", adding it to the Roman Missal among the Masses and Prayers for Various Needs and Occasions. The new prayers and readings were developed in response to the Church's growing emphasis on care for creation and builds upon the theological foundations articulated in Laudato Si'. The decree authorizing the new Mass was issued by the Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments on June 8, 2025, the Solemnity of Pentecost. The Church in the United States has received approval on August 4, 2026 for use in the dioceses of the United States of America. This new set of prayers and readings offers the faithful an opportunity to gather in prayer, giving thanks for God's gift of creation and seeking the grace to exercise responsible stewardship of the earth and its resources.

About the Mass

The Mass for the Care of Creation highlights important themes found throughout Sacred Scripture and Catholic social teaching:

- Gratitude for the gift of creation
- Recognition of humanity's role as stewards of God's creation
- Prayer for the protection and renewal of the environment
- Solidarity with communities affected by environmental degradation and natural disasters
- Commitment to responsible care for the earth for present and future generations

The texts invite the faithful to deepen their relationship with the Creator by reflecting on the beauty of creation and the responsibility entrusted to humanity to cultivate and protect it

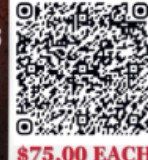
